## **EXHIBITORS**

There will also be a pay on the day doggie game held outside, all dogs over 6 months of age at the show are welcomed to have a go.

At 11am and 1pm you will have the unique opportunity to view a demonstration by Dogs for the Disabled, weather permitting outside.

## **CLASSES**

### **GRADES 1/3 Combined:**

#### **AGILITY/MATCH YOUR TIME (Agility)/JUMPING/STEEPLECHASE**

These classes are intended for dogs and handlers that are eligible for Grades 1,2 or 3, according to KC rules. There may be weaves in these classes except in the steeplechase. This class will consist of only jumps and tunnels and should be fast and flowing.

### **GRADES 4/7 Combined:**

#### **AGILITY/MATCH YOUR TIME (Agility)/JUMPING/STEEPLECHASE**

These classes are intended for dogs and handlers eligible for Grades 4,5,6, or 7 according to KC rules. These classes may contain weaves except in the steeplechase. This class will consist of only jumps and tunnels and should be fast and flowing.

### **MATCH YOUR TIME (Agility):**

This class will be judged according to KC rules. There will be no course time as you, the handler will decide what time your dog will complete the course in. You will inform the scrimmer of your proposed time when on the start line. The placing's will be decided firstly by achieving the least amount of faults i.e. clear round and then the dogs that achieved the course time closest to the proposed course time. The course will be the same for all grades but awards will be given to Grades 1/3 combined and Grades 4 /7 combined.

**STEEPLECHASE** – This is intended as a fast and flowing jumping course. It will only contain jumps and tunnels. The course will be the same for all grades but awards will be given to Grades 1/3 combined and Grades 4 /7 combined.

### **ANYSIZE :**

#### **JUMPING/STEEPLECHASE**

These classes are intended for dogs from 15 months, veterans and dogs that are unable to jump their own height for any reason. Handlers may run at whichever height suits their dog. There will be no weaves or tyre in these classes. This will be run over a different course to Grades 1/3 combined and Grades 4/7 combined.

## HEIGHT CATEGORIES AND JUMP HEIGHTS:

**MICRO** –This height is only available as an option in the **Anysize** class.

**SMALL** – dogs measuring 13.75 inches (350mm) at the withers. Jump height is 14”.

**MEDIUM**- dogs measuring over 13.75 inches (350mm) and measuring 17 inches (430mm) or under at the withers. Jump height is 18”.

**STANDARD** – This height is only available as an option in the **Anysize** class.

**LARGE** –dogs measuring over 17” (430mm) at the withers. Jump height is 26”.

## AWARDS

1<sup>st</sup> place trophy in all classes, 2<sup>nd</sup> place if over 50 dogs entered, 3<sup>rd</sup> place if over 75 dogs entered. Placed rosettes to at least 10% of entries in all classes. Clear round rosettes available in all classes.

## SHOW RULES

1. The Show Secretary reserve the right to refuse entries.
2. Entries are limited. Fees **£11.00** per dog (4 classes). Anysize dogs and dogs aged 15 months **£6** per dog (2 jumping runs).
3. If a change of grade is needed, then it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary before the date of the show.
4. If the maximum number of runs is reached before the official closing date, entries will be declared closed at that earlier date.
5. Competitors must sign and date the declaration on the entry form. One entry form per handler.
6. Handlers not clearing up after their dogs will be asked to leave the show.
7. All dogs entering for this show must be 15 months of age or over.
8. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete at the show or be mated at the venue.
9. Height - the Anysize classes will have jumps set at Standard, Medium, Small and Micro. Handlers may run their dogs when it is at the height best suited for their dog. **All other classes will be run at KC Small. Medium and Large heights.**
10. Competitors are responsible for ensuring they are available for their classes.
11. Dogs may wear a flat nylon or leather collar without attachments (except D ring) when competing. Dogs must not wear any other form of collar, harness or lead.
12. Handlers must not have with them in the ring any training aid such as toys or titbits, with the exception of young dogs in Anysize where silent toys are permitted or when running NFC in other classes. **Handlers running their dogs NFC will be given the course time and a whistle blown when their time is up.**
13. The marking of faults, including contacts to be in line with KC rules.
14. Judges may run their own dogs for competition when they are not scheduled for judging.
15. Any person handling their own or any other dog in a harsh manner will be asked to leave the show.
16. A dog will be removed from the competition if it is: so out of control that it poses a danger to people or dogs at the show, or suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, or otherwise unfit to compete.
17. The organisers are the sole arbiters in respect of all matters and disputes at this event.
18. In the UNFORTUNATE event that the competition has to be cancelled The Show Organiser reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
19. Handlers entered for competition may bring their non-competing dogs to the show. Any spectators planning to bring their dogs to the show must inform the show organisers first.
20. All dogs are entered at their owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, The Show Organiser will not take any responsibility for the loss, damage or injury to dogs, people or property whilst at this show.
21. Competitors must follow the instructions of the stewards with respect to parking and conduct within the show boundaries. Any person being abusive to our helpers will be asked to leave the show.
22. Goods may not be sold within the venue without prior permission from the organisers.
23. No refunds will be made after the closing date or limit is reached.

## **PLEASE HELP AT THE SHOW**

If you're able to help then this will be much appreciated. Please make yourself known to the ring party.

### **TRAINING IN THE RING**

Competitors may, if they so wish, use the course time to train in the ring, using a toy if required & so run "Not For Competition" (NFC). The Scrimmer will then shout NFC to the judge, who may then take a moment to relax. The Scribe must shout Time when the course time has been reached. Competitors must ensure their scribe sheet is annotated NFC.
